Watermain Replacement on Gilley Road from Garratt Boulevard to Keswick Road

Contract: 19ECS-TI-11LR
Start Date: October 19, 2020
End Date: November 6, 2020

In 2019, the City of Toronto replaced the watermain on Gilley Road between Garratt Boulevard and Keswick Road and in the spring of 2020 replacement of substandard water services was completed. Over the summer, the City undertook geotechnical testing at the work site, which delayed the final restoration work needed to complete this project. In October, 2020, the contractor will return to complete final restoration work.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO

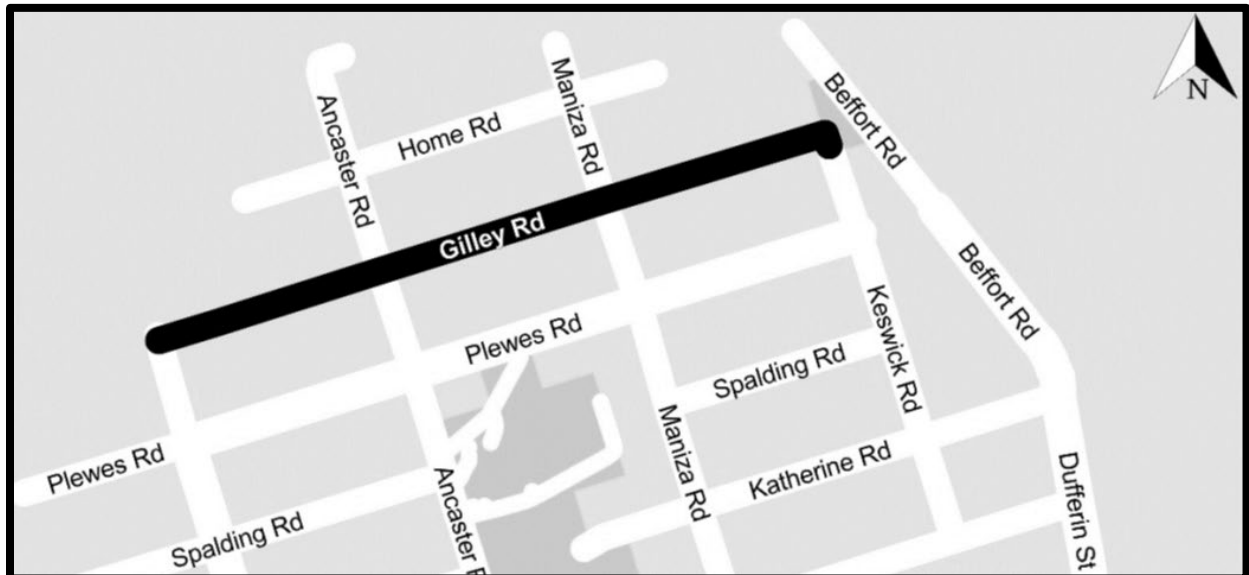

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:


- Restore all areas affected by construction including water service excavations
- Grind the top 40mm of temporary asphalt and place new permanent asphalt





MAP OF WORK AREA



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
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	<p>Physical Distancing: There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, exterior pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility clothing and will maintain physical distancing. If you have questions, call the contact provided on this notice.</p>
	<p>Site Safety: Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the site inspector. If the site inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Garbage & Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. <i>Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</i></p>
