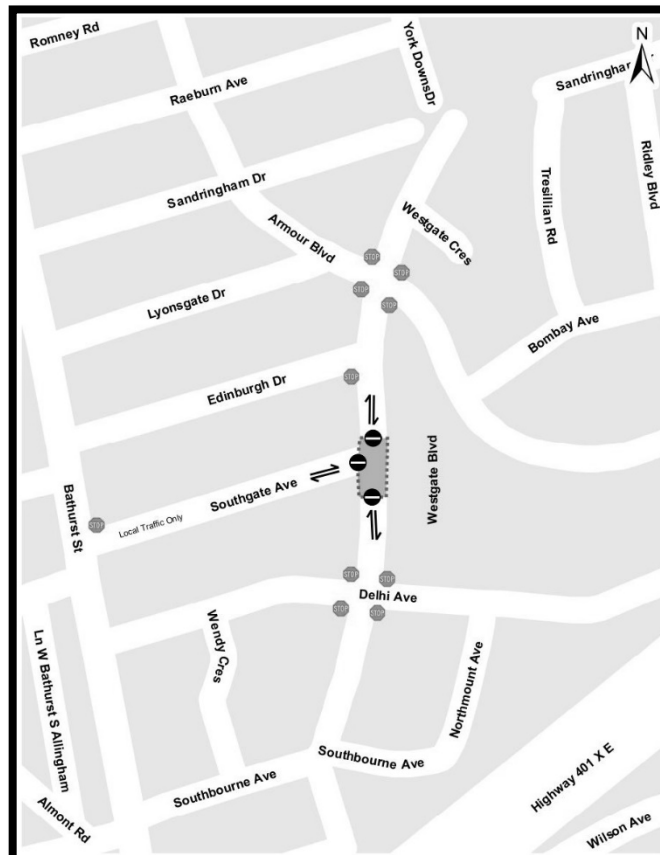

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the sanitary sewer construction work on Westgate Boulevard, the road will be closed at the intersection of Southgate Avenue and Westgate Boulevard effective from 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday August 1, 2023 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday August 15, 2023.

Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists. This project is part of the Council approved 2023 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The intersection at Southgate Avenue and Westgate Boulevard will be fully closed during the duration of the work. Local traffic on Southgate Avenue from Bathurst Street to Westgate Boulevard will be maintained. • Westgate Boulevard will continue to be closed up to Delhi Avenue and access to resident driveways will be provided when it's safe to do so. When your driveway access is impacted, you will receive a notice 48 hours in advance. • There will be detour signs in the area to provide motorists with alternate routes.
	<p>Pedestrians: There are no existing sidewalks; However, safe pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.</p>
